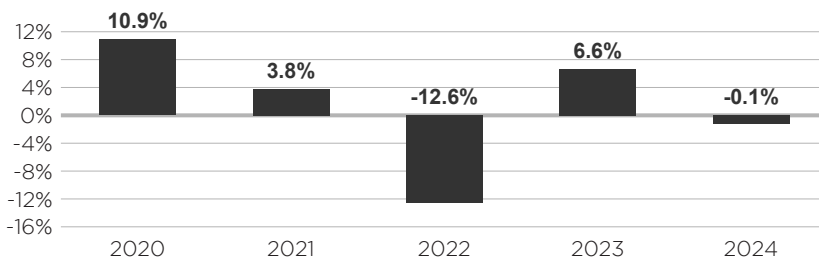
FUND PERFORMANCE
